Call for proposals 2024-2026



The Galerie d'art du Parc team invites professional artists to submit a proposal for the 2024-2026 program.

A non-profit organization founded in 1972, the Galerie d'art du Parc (GAP) was one of the first exhibition centers recognized and supported by the Ministère des Affaires culturelles du Québec in 1974. In 1981, it moved into the Tonnancour's Mansion in Trois-Rivières, historical monument of the city, built in 1723-1725. From 1972 to 2016, the GAP presented 350 exhibitions, showcased the works of more than 2,500 artists from here and abroad, and organized various activities related to exhibitions.

Professional artists who wish to submit a proposal for the 2024-2026 program must do so no later than January 13, 2023 and meet the criteria set out below. The proposals will be evaluated by a programming committee made up of professionals in visual arts who have the representation of diversity at heart and who will seek to get as close as possible to parity.

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

- Correspond to the definition of professional artist according to the four criteria defined in the *Act* respecting the professional status of artists in the visual arts, fine crafts and literature and their contracts with promoters (L.R.Q., c.S-32.01):
 - i. Declare yourself as a professional artist.
 - ii. Create works for his own account.
 - **iii**. His works are exhibited, produced, published, performed in public or marketed by a distributor recognized by his peers.
 - **iv.** Has received recognition as a professional from his peers, through an honorable mention, an award, a prize, a scholarship, an appointment to a jury, selection at a trade show or any other means of the same nature.
- Present a new project or one that has not been presented in the Mauricie and Centre-du-Québec regions.
- Singularity of the thoughts, relevance of the subject and originality of the artistic approach.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

- Artist compensation meets CARFAC standards.
- Transportation for artists from outside the Mauricie region will be reimbursed.
- Accommodation can be provided as needed.
- The Galerie d'art du Parc team will provide assistance with setting up the exhibition.

REQUESTED DOCUMENTS

- A biography of 150 words.
- An artistic approach of no more than 300 words.
- An up-to-date resume.
- Portfolio of 10 images presenting the proposed project.
